The Coastal Carolina Chapter of the Military Officers Association of America (CC-MOAA) will offer five (5) \$1000 academic scholarships for graduating seniors. To be eligible for a CC-MOAA scholarship, the applicant must be a *dependent of an active duty military member permanently* assigned to a command within Carteret, Craven, Jones, or Pamlico Counties; or *dependent of retired military member* living in the aforementioned four counties. Applicants may attend any accredited four year college or university in or out of the State of North Carolina.

Additionally, CenturyLink, in association with Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point and The Coastal Carolina Chapter of the Military Officers Association of America (MOAA), will offer four (4) \$1000 academic scholarships for graduating seniors. To be eligible for this scholarship, the applicant must be a *dependent of an active duty military member permanently* assigned to any command at Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point and be accepted by or attending a four year college or university. Applicants may attend any accredited four year college or university in or out of the State of North Carolina.

We request your assistance in announcing these scholarship programs to your students. Please include the programs in your list of available scholarships to qualified students. An application must be submitted each year to be eligible to compete for a scholarship.
